

The Planeteer Alliance continues to ignite youth-led climate action around the world, empowering young changemakers to tackle the most pressing environmental challenges of our time.

In 2024, the Planeteer Alliance FIRE Summits: Blazing a Trail to Sustainability brought together **over 2,000 young leaders** from **13 countries** across four continents to advance a just transition away from fossil fuels.

With support from the Laura Turner Seydel Living Legacy Fund, 27 FIRE Summits received nearly \$40,000 in grants to convene discussions on clean energy, clean transportation, and clean cooking fuel solutions. Through expert-led sessions, strategy workshops, and community organizing, Planeteers are leading the charge to adopt renewable energy options and build a more sustainable future for all.


